SPECIAL WILD BUNCH NEWS

Effective Jan. 1, 2018, all SASS sanctioned Wild Bunch matches will require pistol magazines to be loaded with SEVEN (7), rather than five (5), rounds. Since this will be quite a change to get used to, both for the stage writers AND the shooters, *AND* since this will mean we have to follow this rule for our SASS NYS WB Championship next April, it has been decided that our last 2 Rough Rider matches of the year will follow this rule. So be prepared!

was held in Pelham, NH, July 20-23, 2017. Turnout for this year's match was very poor, with only 124 shooters in attendance, only 2 of which were from the CKR. But there was plenty of lead-slinging to do with various side events, 3 CAS warmup stages, and a 4stage Wild Bunch mini-match on Thurs., the 10-stage main match on Fri. and Sat., and a 3person team shoot-off on Sun. prior to the awards.
