LONE FEATHER STUDIOS OPEN HOUSE/CAS DEMO

On Sat., July 18th, well-known local Western artist. Schmidt, held his Annual Open House at the Lone Feather Studios in Ballston Spa. Once again, the CKR was invited to present live demonstrations as a part of the day's activities. This was our 5th year there, and the club decided it was time to do something a little different. Instead of shooting regular CAS stages, we decided to do a team shootoff similar to what we do for the Top 16 Shootoff at Heluva Rukus. The weather was "iffy" for setup Fri. night with sprinkles of rain and scads of mosquitoes, but Saturday's weather was the best we've ever had for the event – mid to upper 70s, sunny, a slight breeze, and low humidity – a perfect shooting dav. Twelve cowpokes participated in the shootoffs (one at 12:30 and one at 2:30) which consisted of 2man (or woman!) teams. One team member shot a rifle and 2 pistols; the other shot a rifle, 1 pistol, and a shotgun. Misses were made up with a shotgun, and a rifle reload was required to take down the stop plate for the win. Two teams shot against each other until only one team remained unbeaten. There were some REALLY close rounds and some real blowouts, but everyone seemed to have a blast, and the small. but attentive, group onlookers seemed to enjoy the whole show. Congrats to the team of Blackhands and Peddler Jack who were the overall winners! When not doing the

demos, the club members enioved a delicious buffet and got an opportunity to check out Ken's fabulous Cowboy/Indian/ Mountain Man artwork. An authentic Indian tepee, three beautiful horses and a number of nice hot rods were there as well. Ken generously agreed to sponsor a stage at Heluva Rukus again this year and donated several of his prints. At the conclusion of the event, the names of the cowpokes who attended were thrown into a hat for a drawing for a piece of Ken's art on slate. Congrats to lucky winner, Otter Creek Trapper. A special thanks to all those who participated in the event AND to those who helped with setup and teardown. A good time was had by all!
