The first big match in our neck of the woods - the SASS Pennsylvania State Championship – was held in Muncv Valley, PA. on Memorial Day weekend. There 196 were shooters in attendance. few Α CKR members participated in the event, and some managed to go "packin' wood". home Congrats to Rowdy Bill who took 1st in Silver Senior (12th overall), Annabelle Bransford who took 1st in Ladies 49r, and James Samuel Pike who took 3rd in Wrangler (9th overall). A very honorable mention goes to **Yukon Mike** for taking 10th overall, finishing just out of the trophy distribution for Wrangler class.

Following close on the heels of the PA shoot was the <u>SASS</u> <u>Tri-State</u> <u>Championship</u> (<u>MA/CT/RI</u>), held in Harvard, MA, June 5-7.
