The SASS Arizona State Championship, Bordertown, was held in Tombstone, AZ. Oct. 20-24 A total of 292 shooters competed in the main match, including 4 CKR members. This match gave a whole new meaning to the term "up close and personal" with pistol targets only 10 feet away and rifle targets a whopping 15 feet. You could almost reach out and touch. Took a little getting used to for our folks! Target acquisitions sometimes a bit complex; movement was all lateral; props were nice. The 4-day event included side events and a 3stage mini-match on Thurs., 12 main stages on Fri. and Sat. (6 each day), and more side events prior to awards on Sun. There was food and entertainment available at the range each night, but the CKR gang spend preferred to their evenings in the "Town Too Tough to Die", Tombstone only 2 miles from the range. How cool to dress cowboy and walk down the streets frequented nearly 130 years ago by the likes of Wyatt Earp and Curly Bill Brochius and to visit the OK Corral, the Bird Cage Theatre, and Big Nose Kate's
