## CKR WINNERS AT OTHER MAJOR SHOOTS

The SASS Maine State Championship, Thunder over Beaver Creek, was held in North Berwick, ME, on Sept. 7-9, 2012. A total of 70 shooters participated this year. The shoot consisted of several side events on Fri. and 10 main match stages on Sat. and Sun. (6 Sat./4 Sun.).

And a special congrats to the 2012 SASS Maine State Champions, Splinter Jack (son of our very own Peddler Jack), and No-Nonsense Nancy.

On Oct. 4-7, 2012, the SASS Northeast Regional, a/k/a the Mason-Dixon Stampede, was held in Thurmont, MD. Over 330 shooters participated in this year's match. The weather was much improved over last year, with comfortable temps and no "liquid sunshine" during shooting hours to dampen the cowpokes' spirits. There was a Director new Match and committee running the event, and for their first year at this major undertaking, they did an admirable job. Yes, there is some tweaking to be done, but all-in-all, kudos are in order. There were several new props this year, which was a pleasant change. Stages had a lot of

movement and gun transition and some interesting target acquisitions. The shooters had plenty to keep them occupied for the four-day event (Thurs. side events/warmup stages/Wild Bunch mini-match, Fri. & Sat. 10 main match stages, and Sun. team events, awards ceremony and Top Gun/Sweet Sixteen Shootoff). A good number of vendors were on site throughout the event, and there was even a "food court" this year. A BBQ was held at the range on Fri. night and a more formal banquet at the nearby American Legion Post on Sat. night. Judge Roy Bean, SASS #1, and his wife, Justice Lily Kate, were in attendance at the match.

A major announcement was made at the awards ceremony. The bad news is that as of 2013, this shoot will no longer be a SASS Regional. The good and very exciting news – is that instead, it will be the new SASS **EASTERN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP!!** (Winter Range in Phoenix, AZ, will become the SASS WESTERN National Championship.) Details are yet to be ironed out regarding both SASS National Championships AND realignment of the SASS Regions and Regional Championships nationwide.

Unfortunately, only one CKR member shot the Mason-Dixon this year. Poor Rowdy Bill was relegated to the job of scorekeeper for his posse due to recent knee surgery, but his better half, **Annabelle Bransford**, finished a respectable 3<sup>rd</sup> in L49rs and

made it into the Sweet Sixteen Shootoff. Congrats, Annabelle!

It will be interesting to see how the change in status for this shoot (National vs Regional) affects attendance next year. You might wanna mark your calendars now! A National Championship only 6 hrs. from CKR – pretty cool!

The SASS New Jersey State Championship, Purgatory in the Pines, was held in Jackson, NJ, on Oct. 19-21. A total of 123 shooters took part in the event. The rain on Fri. morning pushed the start of side events back an hour or so, but by afternoon, folks were able to get out on the range and sling some lead in the various speed events and mini-stages. The weather for the 10-stage main match on Sat. and Sun. was undoubtedly the best ever there – sunny and pleasant. Stages were good with some nice new props (loved the mine stage!) and some creative target acquisitions. toughest part of shooting at this range is that it faces the wrong way! The sun in your eyes in the morning can be a real pain at times, but c'est la vie. The Boy Scouts were on hand for the first time this year to assist with brass pickup which was nice. There was a BBQ at the range on Sat. night and a fun Luck-of-the-Draw Shootoff on Sun. prior to the awards.

On Tues. night, Oct. 9<sup>th</sup>, Rowdy Bill and Annabelle Bransford, along with Wheels and Marshal Cartwright, gave a 2+ hour presentation on Cowboy Action Shooting at the Albany County Pistol Club in Albany, NY. There was a decent crowd there, including men, women, and kids, and all seemed quite fascinated by the whole CAS concept.
