


Approximately 160 cowpokes participated in the numerous side matches and wandered along sutlers' row on Friday. The side events this year included the usual speed shotgun/rifle/pistol/derringer/ pocket pistol events, an increase to THREE mini-stages (shot with either CAS or Rough Rider firearms), the long range event, and multiple .22 caliber events. The 11 vendors on site made it all too easy for cowpokes to part with their hard-earned cash. Our three main match sponsors, Klassic Laser Works, Cowboy Gunworks, and Sturm, Ruger & Co., were with us throughout the weekend. Other vendors included a leather maker, a

target maker, photographers, bullet makers/distributors and vendors selling cowboy clothing and other accessories. A special thanks to Tazz and Rose of Klassic Laser Works for the great CKR / HR 2016 customized towels they donated for every shooter and vendor this year - nice mementos and useful as well!

Rowdy Bill did a great job as usual with the main match stages - LOTS of movement, lots of "shooter's choices", and lots of leadslinging fun. There were various movers, pistol knock-downs, rifle knock-ups, the beloved kick-down door, and targets of every size and shape. Target acquisitions were varied and, at times, challenging, keeping the shooters' minds, as well as their body parts, working.
